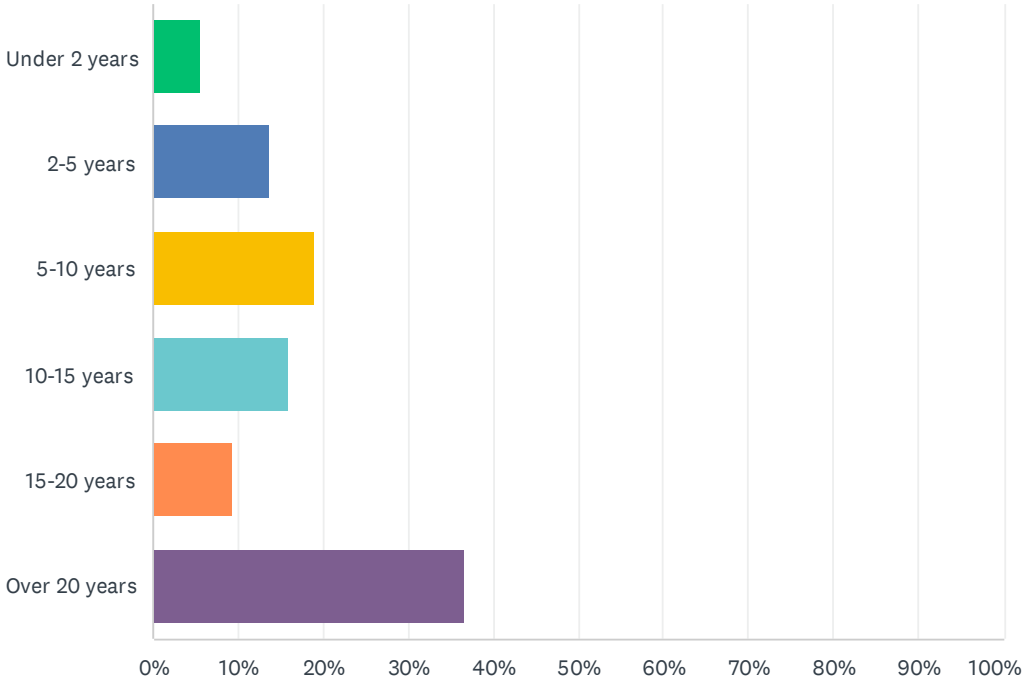


Q1 How long have you been a member of The St Andrews Golf Club?

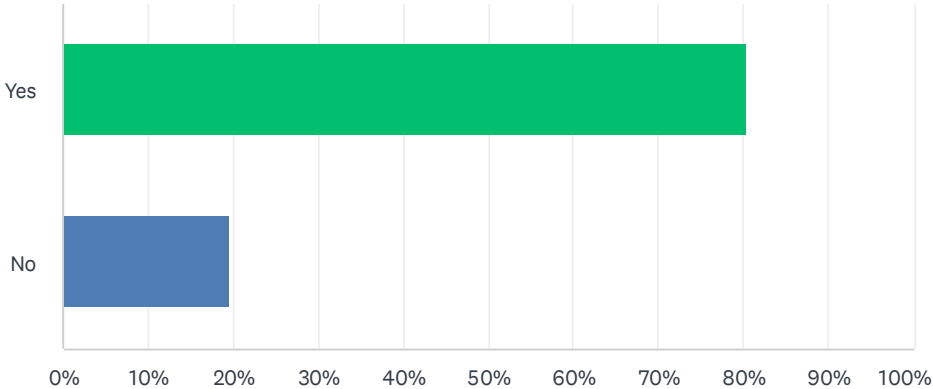

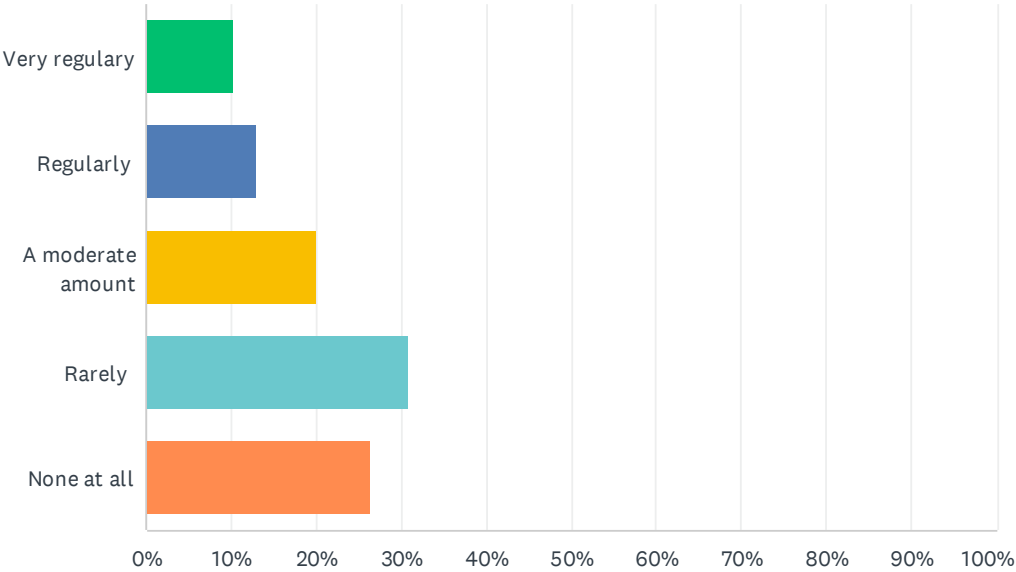

Q4 How often do you play in club competitions

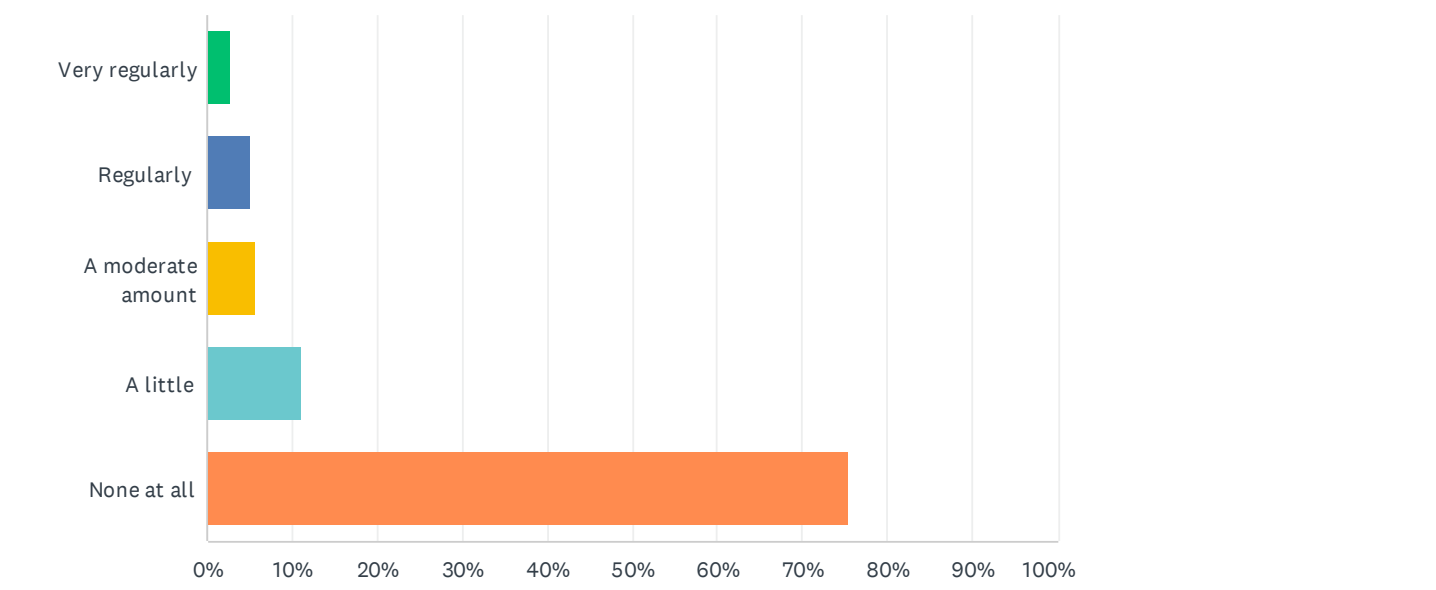

Q5 Do you play in inter club matches?

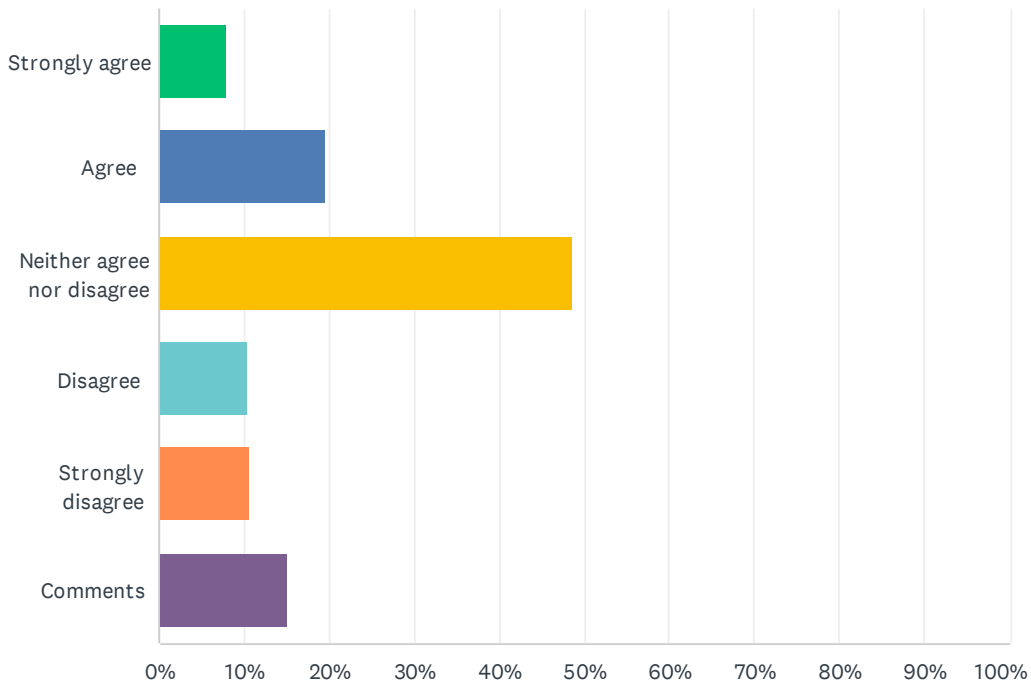

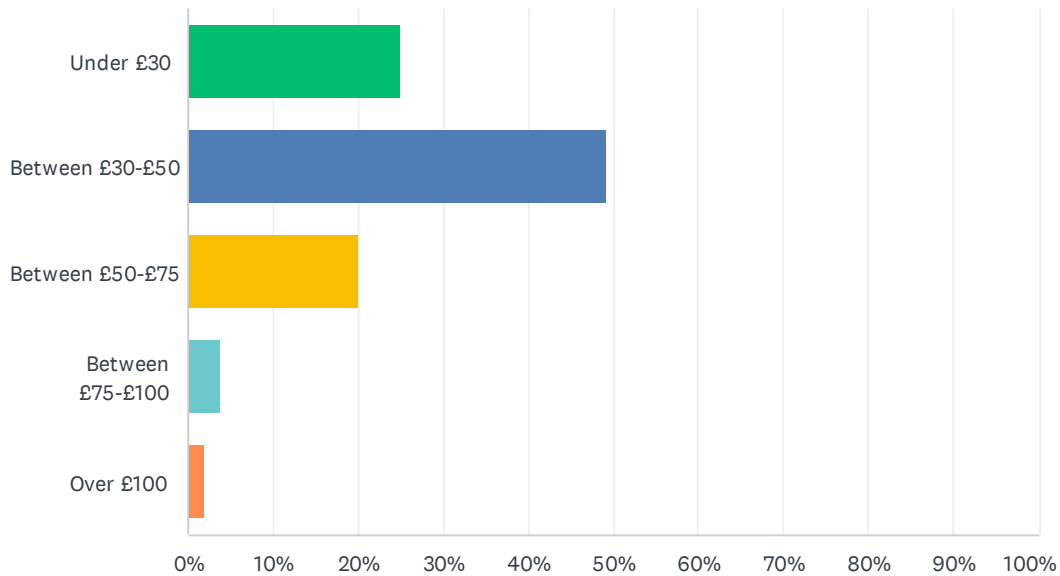

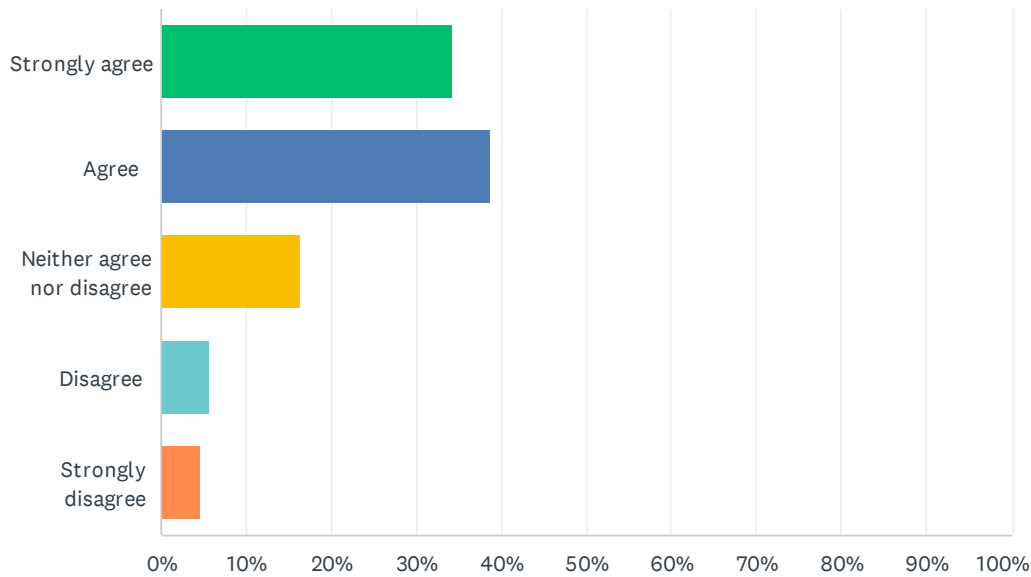
